In House Applications Due January 15, 2010:

Priority for class assignments will be given to In House, then Alumni, Church Mice, and Church Member applications. The application fee is non-refundable if class placement is offered.

In House, September 2010 Tuition Due January 22, 2009:

September 2009 tuition is due in Donna's office by January 22, 2010 in order to hold the class placement offered. The tuition is non-refundable.

First Come, First Serve Public Application and Registration Begins Wednesday, January 20, 2010:

Numbered applications will be distributed to the public at Open House, Wednesday, January 20, 2010 at 7PM. These numbered applications and fee are due by the end of the evening's Open House. Numbered applications turned in after Open House will be logged in order after receipt of the application fee. Applications will continue to be available in the preschool office and will be considered in the order in which they are received with the fee. Our best advertisement is YOU! Please tell your friends, neighbors, relatives, and anyone you hear looking for a preschool, how happy you are at Faith. Tell them we welcome them any day, and invite them to our Open House on Wednesday, January 20th at 7:00 p.m. when our registration for the public begins.

Public Application September 2010 Tuition Due within 3 Business Days of Class Placement Offer:

Public applicants will be notified as soon as possible with an offer of class placement. To hold the class placement, September 2010 tuition is due in Donna's office within 3 business days of the offer. The tuition is non-refundable.

Optional Parent Volunteering:

There is no required parent participation except to provide our classroom with their snack on your scheduled days. Parent help is always welcome, so the teachers will share how they would like to schedule volunteer days.

Tuition Increase:

Cost cutting efforts are underway, but a modest tuition increase is necessary to maintain the preschool's financial health.
